## **Temple Beth Torah Dietary/Kashrut Policy**

Any function held at TBT, whether private or sponsored by the Temple must be "kosher style". All menus must be submitted to the Temple office at lease one (1) week prior to the event for approval.

## What is kosher style?

- Meat and dairy are never served at the same meal, even if they are in separate dishes or served at separate courses
- Shellfish and pork products are completely forbidden
- Fish and eggs are "parve," (considered "neutral"), and can be served with either meat <u>or</u> dairy
- Chicken and other poultry are considered meat
- All products that come from milk are considered dairy (cheese, cream, butter, etc.)

## For example:

Signature of Administrator

<u>Acceptable</u>: turkey sandwiches and chicken sandwiches <u>OR</u> cheese sandwiches being served (but not both)

**<u>Not Acceptable</u>**: turkey with cheese sandwiches being served, a chicken parmigiana entrée, etc.
